

We are your local Safer Community Team.

The team is made up of 1 Sergeant, 2 Police Constables, 3 Police Community Support Officers and 4 Special Constables.

We deal with the longer term issues affecting the community and the lower level crime issues. 24hr cover is provided by an Immediate Response team based at Daventry and Northampton; we are all of course backed by the many specialist support teams and units such as Criminal Investigation Unit, Roads policing etc.

We have an office base at Brixworth the largest village on our sector. The sector covers around 200 square miles and is split into 4 sub beats. Moulton shares its beat with Overstone and Boughton.

Sgt Mike Grady



Mike is responsible for the team and local policing issues. Mike is overseen by Inspector Alan McSharry who is based at Daventry. Alan has to look after all the Safer Community teams across the Daventry council area. We evolved to Safer Community Team (SCT) status at the end of April 2007 and as such are now rarely taken away to assist other areas. As an SCT we have been canvassing the community to find out what your concerns are. A panel of local representatives have considered these returns and the 3 priorities are as follows.

1. Speeding
2. Anti Social behaviour
3. Parking

We have been conducting speed enforcement work in Moulton and have been working with your Parish Council, NCC and Highways regarding the 20mph limit in the centre of the village. Speed and traffic number surveys have been conducted throughout the village and work based on these results will be objectively considered.

Arrangements are in hand for additional road markings, sign movements followed by phased education and enforcement.

We have dealt with a number of specific parking issues and will continue to monitor areas of concern.

Your SCT along with partners will continue work to tackle these issues.

PC Gary Wright

Gary has a responsibility for Moulton and will deal with criminal offences and enforcement issues. Like the other Police Constable he has half the area to cover so is understandably busy.





PCSO Allan Whenmouth

Community Support officers are the eyes ears and visible presence of modern policing – in effect what most understand a village bobbie to be. Allan is the Community Support Officer for Moulton, Overstone and Boughton. You will see Allan out on patrol. We now have use of a base in the village in order to try to increase the time on patrol on your sub beat.

PC Paul Houghton Draeger

Paul has responsibility for Brixworth and the half of the sub beat not covered by Gary; suffice to say we will all 'police' anywhere across the sector as necessary.



PCSO Glyn Lewis

Glyn covers a huge area to the northwest and east of our sector. Glyn was also covering Moulton but when the team was increased in size with Allan in was decided that Glyn would relinquish your parish. Glyn of course still has much experience of Moulton and remains involved and in touch.

Jo covers Brixworth and nearby villages. Jo joined the team in Aug 07 and was tutored by PCSO Jemma Simkins who has taken a career break.
